The light, bright rooms of the iconic Tate Modern were a perfect setting for the works. The huge colourful pictures using naturally inspired

The exhibition was disappointing in only one respect: it was very difficult to actually see the pictures through the heads of the other visitors. The gallery introduced timed tickets to keep the audience moving, but this was not enough to reduce the overcrowding. By the end of the exhibition, real patience was required to endure the queue to buy posters and cards at the shop.



In spite of the crowds, 'Henri Matisse: The Cut-Outs' was an exhibition not to be missed. But the only way to really appreciate it was to follow the example of many visitors and go back more

than once.

Tell us your views.

In the past decade, many galleries have organised 'blockbuster' exhibitions of wellloved artists to attract visitors, but there have been many problems with overcrowding. Some say galleries could try showing one- or two-picture exhibitions in one room of their permanent exhibition space and could look at lowering the entry fee. Galleries might want to operate a queuing system so that visitors in the room are limited.
